I have found over many years that if we are made aware of a situation early that often it is able to be resolved in a fairly easy manner. Difficulties arise where we are not made aware of situations and they continue to grow and become more difficult. The Student Service Office is great point of contact and they can initially handle any concerns or questions and involve appropriate staff. Mrs Shari Dearman, Mrs Emma Pay and Mrs Karen Smith look after the SSO, all have had their own children at Temple, they have a wealth of experience and would love to be able to help in any matter. They are a great sounding board, so if you are unsure in about anything just give them a call. The team in the SSO is led by Mr Justin

Kowald, Assistant Principal Student Development, who has a great desire to see every student succeed and do well.

A key value of the school is resilience and it is a character quality that we really want to develop in all students. It is developed as students step out of their comfort zone and face challenges. Our camps provide great opportunities to develop resilience and are structured to challenge the students. This is done in a supportive and encouraging environment. It is good if students are feeling unsure or a little fearful about an activity or even about going on camp. These are great opportunities to develop resilience and will help in their growth and ability to deal with life. As parents it is not our role to prevent our child from ever having to experience anything difficult, it is to support and encourage them as they work through the difficulties and challenges. As adults we know life does not always go to plan and can be difficult. We need young people who are resilient and are prepared to be able to take on the challenges as they enter into adult life. We have had our Year 12 camp at Woodhouse in Week 1, our Year 10 camp at Mylor in Week 3 and our Year 8 students are off to camp in Week 5.

Mission trips are a really important part of the life of the school and definitely a great opportunity to be involved in ministry overseas and grow in resilience. We have 2 trips each year, the first is to PNG working at the Sunrise Bethel School in Pt Moresby. This trip is for students in Years 10, 11 or 12 and is at the start of Term 3. The second trip is to Cambodia and is for students in years 10 or 11. This occurs at the end of Term 3. More information can be found in our Mission Possible Newsletter that has been enclosed.

Our Interhouse Athletics will be on Wednesday, March 8. This is held at the Santos stadium and is a great day. It is the only event in the year where all students and staff from both campuses come together for the day. There is a separate Interhouse Athletics Shield for each campus. Parents are very welcome to join us for the day.

It has been really exciting to see the students lead out in Assembly and in the various prayer groups, bible studies and Friday morning praise and worship. God is doing something really special, as students step out of their comfort zone and are becoming even more bold in expressing their faith. Please continue to pray for us and especially the students as they lead out in faith.

NUT AWARENESS

This is a reminder that the school has chosen to become a "Nut Aware" school.

This awareness has been implemented because there is an increased number of students at our school who have severe peanut/nut allergies. These students cannot be exposed to nuts in ANY form, as this will trigger an anaphylactic reaction - that is a reaction requiring an immediate injection of adrenalin, ambulance attendance and hospitalization.

This has very serious consequences for our students and in their best interests, we ask that care is taken with all peanut/nuts and food containing nuts within the school. The Canteen/Home Ec. has also undertaken the change.

The school acknowledges that due to food processing practices, it is impractical to eliminate nuts or nut products entirely from an environment where there is food. Thus "Nut Aware" School.
