1. REMEMBERING

Use flash cards or recite information to help remember important facts or concepts learnt during the term.

2. UNDERSTANDING

Show your understanding by explaining concepts learnt to your family and friends. Practice old tests or review past work and find out where your gaps in your understanding is and find out the right answers.

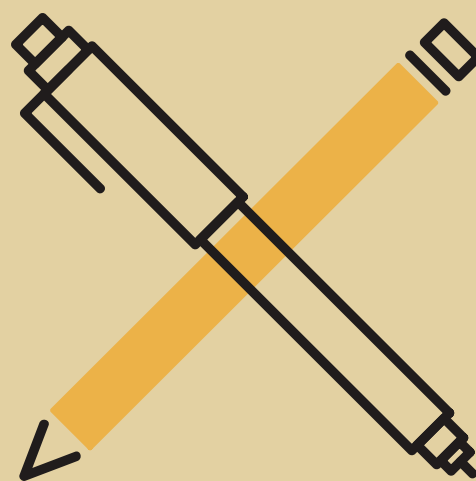


3. APPLYING
