



Mentor Project Exhibit Student Task Sheet

Information

The Homecoming Ceremony is a time to celebrate the talents and skills learnt through the mentor program and to show appreciation for the time spent together and the connections formed. It is an evening for mentors, families and students. Together with their mentor, each student will create an exhibit which displays The Rite Journey project they have completed with their mentor during the year as well as a poster which provides a reflection on the mentoring process.

Time frame

- Term 1 – Term 3: Work on The Rite Journey project with mentor & log hours after each visit
- Term 4: Create poster for exhibit

Exhibit Requirements

Your mentee's Rite Journey Mentor Exhibit for the Homecoming Ceremony must include the following:

- Final project displayed
- Poster describing project (must be A2 in size) - must be creative and thoughtfully put together, neat, and with correct grammar and spelling. It must answer the following questions:
 - What did you learn or make? (Brief title/statement)
 - What were the steps involved in the process? (In detail, describe the different steps in the process of learning your new skill or creating your product. Include at least six photographs of the process (at least three that include you and your mentor)) (around three paragraphs)
 - What did you learn from your mentor? (at least one paragraph)
 - What did you most enjoy about the mentor program? (at least one paragraph)
 - Would you consider being a Rite Journey mentor in the future? Explain. (at least one paragraph)
