Our Inter House Athletics Carnival is a great day for the four Houses to battle it out on various track and field events.

There are also novelty events that students are welcome to participate in also. Medallions will be awarded to the student who scores the most points in individual events at each age group and there is a shield presented to the winning House.

Each student has been placed in one of the four Houses, North (red), South (blue), East (green) or West (orange) and is permitted to get dressed up in their House colours at this carnival, however clothing must be suitable for participation in sports events.

Students are required to participate in at least 3 events (these events may include field events, track events or novelty events) plus each student must help with officiating an event. We are trying to encourage all our students to support their House in any way possible.

All students will need to wear a hat at all times unless competing in events. Sun-screen will be available, but students are encouraged to bring their own. Students will also need to provide their own lunch. Water will be provided free of charge and students will need to bring their own drink bottle to refill. There is a canteen available throughout the day.

Students who would like to represent the school in athletics at the South Australian Christian Schools Carnival (SACSA) in Week 9 and at the Secondary Schools Sports South Australian Carnival (SSSSA) in Week 11 will need to make sure they participate on the day in their chosen events.

After Care Group, students will walk to Santos Stadium with a number of teachers, and remain there for the day. They will be dismissed from the stadium at approximately 3.00pm. This will give students time to catch public transport. The School buses will collect students from the venue at the conclusion of the carnival.
