### What is VET?

VET courses are Vocational Education and Training courses that students in Year 10 (for school-based apprenticeships or taster courses), 11 or 12 can undertake as a subject toward their SACE. These courses are typically delivered on or off campus and completion by the student provides credits towards a recognised VET qualification within the Australian Qualifications Framework

Universities may accept a completed Certificate III or higher as the fourth 20 Credit option for calculation of the ATAR for university entrance.

VET courses can be a valuable part of a student's secondary education. It is important for both students and parents to carefully consider the reasons for undertaking a VET course while at school.

A VET course may be a good choice if:

- You have a clear idea about your career pathway and the course is going to give you skills and a qualification towards your goal.
- You have a strong interest in that vocational industry area.
- You are good at managing your time, staying organised and learning independently. Students who do VET courses often miss lessons in other subject areas and will therefore be responsible to complete missed work during study time at school and at home.
