Student Drivers & Passengers Policy

TO AND FROM SCHOOL:

Should students choose to drive to school the following instructions are to be noted:

Students are not permitted to access their vehicle for any reason once they arrive at school.

Student drivers are to exercise extreme care when driving in the vicinity of the School and abide by all speed limits and road rules in regards to parking.

The School does not accept responsibility for private vehicles.

Traffic delays will not be regarded as legitimate reasons for ongoing lateness.

Student drivers must learn to negotiate and allow for delays that often arise on our roadways so that they arrive at school on time.

TO AND FROM EXCURSIONS:

In very limited circumstances a senior staff member may consider it appropriate that students drive to locations. On the express permission of the Principal and in such circumstances, a separate consent form will be issued for both driver and passenger.

The forms must be filled out by parents and submitted to the Campus Assistant Principal, Student Development prior to the day of the excursion. A written response will be recorded in the Student Planner and co-signed by the Subject Teacher.

Permission WILL NOT be given for on the spot or ad hoc requests.

Verbal consent to drive or to be driven will not be accepted under any circumstances.
